

**Cep** *Boletus edulis* [Phillips (2006) p276] also known as Penny bun. Common, summer to late autumn in deciduous, coniferous and mixed woodland. Cap brown with white bloom at first expanding to leave a white line at the margin. Smooth and dry initially, becoming greasy, slightly sticky in wet weather, later polished. Stem usually swollen, a white network more obvious towards the top. Flesh white, pores white then discolouring yellow then greenish yellow with age. Edible, excellent.
