

Birch Bolete *Leccinum scabrum* [Collins p24]
[ECSS visit No.2]. Frequent, only under birch in



woods or margins. Cap hemispherical when young, later evenly convex, slippery when moist. Pores whitish-grey when young, not blotching when bruised. Flesh whitish-grey, occasionally pink when cut or turning greenish blue, Stem whitish-grey covered entirely with grey scales, long, base slightly thicker. Very palatable when young. Segment SW10.
