

**Common Bonnet** *Mycena galericulata* [Phillips (2006) p81] [ECSS visit No.53]. Very common, in clusters on stumps and fallen branches of broad-leaved trees, all year. Cap conical expanding to a bell-shaped with a raised centre, brown or grey-brown, paler and ridged at the margin. Stem, hollow, similar colour to cap, paler at top, base covered in fine white fibres. Smell mealy when crushed, rancid. Gills white, becoming flesh-pink. Edible; but not worth it!
