

Porcelain Fungus *Oudemansiella mucida* [Phillips (2006) p116]. Collins refers to Porcelain *sic* in the index; but on p96 refers to Slimy beech cap! [ECSS visit No.38]. Common, on the trunks of beech, often high up in clusters, late summer to late autumn. Cap slimy, semi-translucent. Stem, fine lines above the membranous ring, slightly scaly below. Edible after washing to remove gluten.
