

**Oyster Mushroom** *Pleurotus ostreatus* [Phillips (2006) p266]. On rowan, January 2011. Common, often in large clusters on stumps and fallen or standing trees, usually deciduous, all year. Cap convex then flattening or slightly depressed often wavy and lobed at margin, or splitting. Flesh white, smell pleasant. Gills white, then with yellowish tinge (but this specimen brown?). Edible.
