

Turkeytail *Trametes versicolor/coriolus versicolor* [Phillips p317] [ECSS visit No.13]. Very common, on deciduous wood, all year. A very variable species. Bracket, large overlapping tiered groups. Colour very variable, concentrically zoned with white or cream margin. Upper surface velvety, smooth with age. Flesh white, smell not distinctive. Pores white, yellowish or light brown. Not edible.
